Pell Grant Talking Points

- Removing barriers to access and attainment in higher education provides a strong return on investment for the economy, tax payers, and students.
- Maintaining current student eligibility for a maximum Pell Grant at the current 12 credit hours per term requirement should be a top priority
- One third of Minnesota State 2-year Community and Technical Colleges have over 50% of students receiving Pell.

- All 26 colleges in the Minnesota State 2-year Community and Technical College system have over 30% of students receiving Pell.

- One third of Minnesota State 2-year Community and Technical Colleges have over 50% of students receiving Pell.

- Students cannot afford cuts to critical financial aid during a time of rising living costs, and our economy cannot afford to have students lose access to the education and training they need to succeed in the labor market.
